




IRISH AUTHOR SPEAKS OF A BRAVE NEW WORLD - WITHOUT MONEY!



Dublin-born author and broadcaster Colin R. Turner has been causing quite a stir since the release of his second book *Into The Open Economy* in early October. The 92 page mini-book soared to the Amazon top ten within a week of its release and has already secured Turner a regular slot on RTV's *Marbella Now* TV programme.

Turner, now living in Fuengirola, describes his book as '*a simple recipe for a better world beyond money.*'

He explains, “Imagine for a moment that money and trade were not requirements for your existence. It doesn't take much to see the myriad of problems that would be solved overnight if that were the case.

“There would be no more poverty or social inequality, for example. No more reckless destruction of the environment to turn a profit. All the associated problems of greed, competition, corruption and crime would become almost non-existent.

“But, most importantly, we would each be able to live richer, happier and more connected lives, with less stress, while being able to reach our fullest individual potential.”


He continues, “There’s no doubt that the rewards of a money-free world would be immense, so maybe it's time for us to consider the question: is a world without money possible?

“Of course it's possible!” Colin states. “We can do anything we want. And it’s not just possible – and better – it’s actually really easy, by collectively changing our habits and expectations just a little.

“Technology and automation have made the day to day business of providing for ourselves easier than ever before. But we are not sharing in that bounty because our trading ideology prevents it. It is entirely technically possible to provide for everyone's basic needs today, but we are stuck in a centuries-old habit where we feel we must trade in order to progress. Once we defeat that habit, amazing things will become possible.”

Turner's debut novel *F-Day: The Second Dawn Of Man*, released in July of this year, presents a fictional dramatisation of events leading up to a money-free world. Also an Amazon top ten seller, the five-star rated thriller gives a compelling visualisation of a near future utopia, and there is already talk of a movie.

Turner concludes, “It's been a bit of a rollercoaster ride since releasing *F-Day* in July. It turns out there is a huge appetite – not just for this story – but for change. It's almost like everyone knows this kind of seismic change is coming. The market system we use only works for a relatively small percentage of people, and people are now starting to realise that for themselves.”



Turner, who is also the founder of the popular global initiative [*The Free World Charter*](#), advocates what he calls an *Open Economy*, describing it as: 'a system where a common understanding exists that enables everyone to benefit everyone, including themselves.' [see [wikipedia](#)]

He explains, “That common understanding is about where we place our priorities – which are completely misplaced at the moment. We, as a species, urgently need to move from self interest to group interest.

“Unless we place our common welfare as our central concern, we are likely to destroy the world we share beyond repair. This is what happens when 7.2 billion people focus on self interest.

“An Open Economy is not about all becoming hippies and holding hands across the world – it's about finally recognising our commonality and becoming responsible for the long term viability of all our species.”
